

General Data Privacy Statement

We appreciate your interest in our company. The protection of your personal data is very important to us. Your personal data will always be processed in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation and the Austrian Telecommunications Act (TKG 2003) as well as the country-specific data protection regulations that are applicable to us.

In this data protection statement, we would like to inform you of the key aspects of the data processing carried out in the context of our business relationship.

1. Purposes of Data Processing

Legal basis of performing a contract or preparing for one

- Sale of our products
- Collection of customer data as part of product registration (warranty extension)
- Provision of training (ekey Academy)

Legal basis of the company's legitimate interests

- Winning new customers and winning back former customers
- Increasing customer satisfaction and customer retention through customer surveys (e.g., after-sales), organizing competitions at trade shows
- Recording phone conversations as part of a service call (support)
- Distributing promotional materials (e.g. newsletter) for the company's goods and services ("marketing purposes")

2. Description of Legitimate Interests Relating to Marketing Purposes

We process your data so that we can use it for the purpose of marketing products and services of our company. Only the data that we hold as a result of the contractual relationship will be processed. The primary aim of this data processing is customer retention and acquisition with the aim of entering into a (pre-)contractual relationship. We wish to notify you that the personal data that we process for marketing purposes will not be transferred by us to any third party (except the website host).

3. Right to Object to the Processing of Data for Marketing Purposes

You have the right to object at any time to the use of your personal data for marketing purposes without having to specify your reasons. As a result of your objection, we will stop processing your personal data for these purposes from that moment on.



4. Subscription to Our Newsletter

On our Internet site, you are given the option of subscribing to our company's newsletter. The input screen for ordering the newsletter determines which specific items of personal data will be sent to the person responsible for processing when you order the newsletter. The personal data that are collected when you sign up to the newsletter will only be used for the purpose of sending you our newsletter. This data will not be passed on to third parties. You may cancel your subscription to our newsletter at any time.

5. Contact Information on Our Homepage

Our homepage contains information that enables people to contact us quickly using electronic means. If you contact us electronically, the personal data you send us will be stored automatically. Personal data such as this, which you send to us on a voluntary basis, are stored for the purposes of processing the data or contacting you. This data will not be passed on to third parties.

6. Evaluation of Personal Aspects

For the purpose of providing optimum customer care, we store details of customer activities (e.g., orders, complaints, and so on) so that relevant and purposeful steps may be taken to improve customer satisfaction or customize our service.

7. Automated Decision-making

You are not subject to any automated decision that produces legal effects concerning you.

9. External Recipients of Data

The data will not be sent to third parties, except where it is transferred to the transport or shipping company that we commission for the purpose of delivering the goods, and to our tax accountant for the purpose of meeting our obligations under tax law. Similarly, data may be shared with our website administrator.

10. Transfer to Third Countries

We do not share any personal data for processing outside of the EU.

11. Storage Period

The data are stored by virtue of the legal bases specified above. Accounting data, invoices, and supporting documents will be deleted no earlier than 7 years after the business relationship comes to an end, with the seven-year period commencing at the close of the calendar year.

12. Your Rights

Based on Art 15. GDPR "Disclosure" You have the right to request information as to whether your personal data are being processed.

Based on Art 16. GDPR "Correction" You have the right to demand, without undue delay, the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you or to have these data supplemented if they are incomplete.

Based on Art 17. GDPR "Deletion" You have the right to demand the erasure of your personal data without undue delay where the grounds specified in Art 17 (1) GDPR are fulfilled.

Based on Art 18. GDPR "Restriction" You have the right to demand that the processing of the personal data be restricted where the grounds specified in Art 18 (1) GDPR are fulfilled.

Based on Art 20. GDPR "Data portability" You have the right to receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format.

Based on Art 21. GDPR "Objection" You have the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data that are being processed based on the basis of your consent.

Based on Art 77. GDPR "Right of complain" You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority if you believe that the processing of the personal data violates this regulation.
